**APPROVAL OF MINUTES**

Upon motion by C. Taft and second by T. Kleist that the minutes of the April 3, 2006 meeting of the Architectural Review Board be approved as submitted. Motion passed.

**OLD BUSINESS**

**60 ½ Salina Street sign – State Farm Insurance, Lindsay Luu ...**

Lindsay Luu stated she has submitted a new proposal and her corporate office allowed her to work with Syracuse Signage to come up with something she feels will be acceptable to the ARB. She stated she wanted something simple and provided the Board Members with a sample of the colors. The sign will have a white face and will be 3' x 7' double-sided MDO. The lettering will be vinyl. Her name will be black and the logo for State Farm Insurance will be in red.

T. Kleist asked what the sign will be mounted on. Ms. Luu stated it will be mounted on pressure treated 4 x 4 posts. D. Johnson suggested she should have the posts painted. C. Taft asked if the sign will have an outline. Ms. Luu stated it will be black and D. Mott noted the application states it will be a vinyl appliqué border.

D. Johnson stated he would like to see finials on the sign to dress it up. He noted this sign will be replacing the existing sign and asked what kind of lighting will be utilized. Ms. Luu stated she will keep the landscape lighting so the sign will be illuminated from the ground.

Upon motion by T. Kleist and second by C. Taft to approve a proposal from Lindsay Luu for a new sign made of MDO board with vinyl lettering in black and a red logo. The sign shape will be as proposed outlined in black with 4" x 4" pressure treated painted posts. The sign will include a finial selected by Ms. Luu and will be illuminated from the ground. **Motion passed.**

**Discussion/Vote regarding new ARB Chair ...**

D. Johnson stated they need to select a new ARB Chair. T. Kleist suggested this issue be tabled until next month's meeting to wait for E. Mercer to be present. D. Johnson agreed and stated it will be tabled until June. D. Mott expressed interest in the position.
