This cleanup will take place along designated banks and shore areas of the Seneca River located in Mercer Park, Community Park, Canal Park, Meadow Street and the Sergei Yevich Trail and other areas of the village.

This cleanup signifies the 16th such effort of the Village's Stormwater Management Program, which took effect on March 10, 2003. This program requires the Village to reduce the contaminants and solids that are entering these waters. This cleanup is one of the many management tools the Village uses to achieve these cleanup goals.
