TOBACCO-FREE POLICY

Policy statement will be adopted as follows:

In as much as the Village of Baldwinsville is committed to providing a high quality of living for all residents and recognizes that there is no safe level of exposure to secondhand smoke and that tobacco use in the proximity of children, youth, and adults engaging in or watching recreational activities is unhealthy the following policy is adopted.

Tobacco-free Policy

It is hereby determined to be the policy of the Village of Baldwinsville that the use of tobacco products within Mercer, McHarrie, and Diane Reeves Little League parks and associated facilities is prohibited.

Compliance Procedures

The enforcement of this policy is through voluntary compliance.

1. Designated park land and facilities will be signed indicating that these facilities are tobacco-free. Areas where tobacco use is permitted may be designated at the discretion of the Village Engineer.
2. The Village Engineer will meet with Village employees and officials, activity organizers, leaders, and coaches as necessary to enhance the awareness of and compliance with this policy.
3. Village staff will be responsible for enforcing this policy and for promoting cooperation with and awareness of this policy.
