Book Club News
While Justice Sleeps by Stacy
Abrams

Unfortunately, many of us have busy lives and were unable to read the book, however a couple very diligent members read the book and were able to fill in the rest of the group. Stacy Abrams is very much in the political spotlight these days. She ran for governor of Georgia, but lost; however, she was determined to get out the minority votes in Georgia, resulting in a change of the political structure of the state. Using her

political knowledge and her experience as an author, Abrams has created a book full of intrigue, twists and turns, leaving one reader feeling. the book required a map. At times there were so many plot lines that it was confusing to understand; maybe that's why it took her 12 years to write the book. She used many family members to research their areas of expertise and acknowledged them, but she most likely wrote from experience when including back room dealings and behind-the-scenes decisions. Showing the readers and solidifying the options of those who find politics to be less than forthright, the politician is a complicated animal.' A young law clerk, the protagonist of the story, if left to decipher a cryptic message a Supreme Court Justice in the throes of a stroke, gives her, before he lapses into a coma. Her journey to decipher this message and clues it leaves is the basis for the plot.

Those who read the book felt that Abrams definitely left the ending open so a sequel could follow. Those who read this book found it interesting and entertaining despite the convoluted plot and said they might read the sequel to see what happens to the characters left in limbo.

Out next meeting is August 17th at 2pm. We will be discussing <u>The Personal Librarian</u> by Maria Benedict and Victoria Christopher Murray. It is a fictional account centered around a woman hired to curate a library collection for the Pierpont Morgan Library built by JP Morgan. In this position, it gives Belle de Costa Green, a place in society and she becomes a powerhouse in the art
