The HEAP program may help you pay for: electricity, gas, oil, coal, propane, wood, or kerosene. Even if your heat and utilities are included in your rent, HEAP may be able to help you.

Just give me a call at 315-638-4536 and ask to be added to the list. *The deadline is December 6th*. Medicare open enrollment ends on December 7th for those of you who are considering a change in your coverage.

B'VILLE EXPRESS

DO YOU NEED TRANSPORTATION? WE CAN HELP!

The *B'ville Express* is now <u>OPEN</u> and accepting ride requests. Due to COVID, there are new guidelines that must be followed by all. <u>All riders must be fully vaccinated in order to use the program.</u>

Prior to using the program, a home visit must be made so I can verify your vaccination status and your current mobility status. If you have not yet received a home visit, please make sure to call me @315-638-4536 to schedule one as soon as possible so you can receive rides. Please remember to call 7 days prior to

your need for a ride. All drivers and riders must wear a mask while being transported. All our drivers have been vaccinated. If you are **MEDICAID ELIGIBLE**, please utilize the **Medicaid free transportation** for medical appointments as the number of drivers we currently have is very limited.

If you have not been vaccinated and need transportation you can utilize the **OSCAR** free senior ride program. Their number is 315-442-3434. Make sure to specifically ask for the **OSCAR** program when you call.

Winter quickly approaching along with hazardous driving conditions. The *B'ville Express* does not provide rides if the Baldwinsville Schools are closed due to inclement weather. If schools are not closed, yet the weather is questionable, the volunteer driver will use their discretion in taking you to your appointment. If your ride with *B'ville Express* is cancelled, it is your responsibility to cancel any appointments for that day. When you have rescheduled your appointment, please remember to schedule your ride with us.

ARE YOU LOOKING TO VOLUNTEER YOUR TIME?

The *B'ville Express* has an urgent need for volunteer drivers to transport seniors in our community to their appointments, helping them to remain independent. Without transportation, many of our senior neighbors are unable to access essential services. Volunteer drivers will register with the *B'ville Express* by calling Gina @315-638-4536.


