Book Club News Book Review of The Razor's Edge By Somerset Maughum.

We had the best conversation about

this book that we have had in a long time! After initial discussions in general about the novel. The book was laden with detail. As an example, Maughan describes a party guest as beautiful...but fat. He then proceeded to detail each part of her and added the word, "but fat" in each description. It was almost too much for those of us who are used to the speed of the computer age and unspoken detail a television offers us. This book, published in 1944, certainly was before the days of the little screen. The detail made the book exceedingly slow to read and his use of vocabulary readers found daunting. We discussed why the detail and vocabulary was so important and what that revealed about us, the author, and the period of time in which the novel was set. The author also, sets himself inside the novel and readers found that confusing.

The book centers around a main character, Larry, who has come back from World War I traumatized. He begins to search for the meaning of his existence and the purpose of life. He questions his decision to marry, his station in life, and his social stature. He is a non-conformist, where money means nothing.

(Although, we felt it is people who have money that can take such a stance.) He cancels his wedding plans and travels abroad (try doing that with no money) to seek a solution. He is torn between doing his own self enlightenment and following convention expected of his upper-class background. He eventually turns to nonwestern philosophy in an attempt to explain society's ills. It is from this philosophy comes the title...

"He had everything and wanted nothing. He saved the world and then it shattered. The path to enlightenment is as sharp and narrow as a razor's edge."

Because none of us were thrilled by it, I asked the group why they thought Alex Trebek called this one of his favorite books.

In an interview Trebek responded by saying. "It's about a young man, searching for the truth, searching for God, searching for — whatever, a reason for living. I went through that, and in many ways, I'm still going through that. It's struck a very receptive chord in me."

We all found the book tedious to read ... (must be we are all pretty much in touch with ourselves..haha)

Since the facilitator of the group had cataract sugery she could not read the book so, I relied on the information from the members of the group.

The main characters were two very opposites... in sex, age, race, ethnic background, financial status, physical agility and ability, and the ability to interact socially yet, they became the best of friends.

Mildred Gutermann is a 90-year-old German Jew who has need of a personal assistant, and somehow Luis, the assistant, has disappeared. Raymond Jaffa, an outcast who is losing his best friend due to a move, lives in the same building, and notices her confusion one day. She needs to find Luis, but her blindness and advanced age is prohibiting her from searching for him.

Raymond comes from a very dysfunctional home life. He is the only child of a bi-racial couple who have since divorced and he is now a minority within his own home and with a white mother, a white stepfather and white stepsisters. He feels worthless, and alone even in the big city of New York.

He befriends Mildred because he is searching for someone who finds him worthy. She always praises him and makes him feel value. Everyone else has ignored him, but his polite manners and solicitous nature ender him to her. A trust is formed between the two. He helps her while secretly looking for the aid who seems to have abandoned her.

In his search for Luis, Raymond uses the internet and finds many Luis Valdez's. So beginning a the top of the list he tracks down each one to see if this is indeed the correct Luis... the novel is based on the encounters of each person and Raymond is definitely going "outside the box" which adds to his exposure and growth.

Eventually Raymond's research leads him to the fate of Mildred's Luis Velez. the novel ends with that story. The novel has many uplifting moments with Raymond finding many Luis's who contributed in a positive and negative way to his search. Raymond grew as a person in that he was more outgoing and more self-confident and mad a friend for life in Mildred.

What are we going to read next? We decided to break out of the "safe zone" books and read some of these books listed below to form our own opinions. Since there is a new bookstore in town perhaps you might want to grab a book and join us for what could be a lively conversation. The American Library Association, Office for Intellectual Freedom tracked 729 challenges to library, school, and university materials and services in 2021. Of the 1597 books

that were targeted, here are the most challenge.
