## Neighborhood Advisor / Outreach

Let the festivities begin!! The holiday season will be starting soon!! Which means those of you who want to sign up to have holiday meals delivered need to let me know. The meals are delivered by the Rescue Mission on Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. I need your request for the **Thanksgiving meal by the 4<sup>th</sup> of November** and requests for the Christmas meal by December 2<sup>nd</sup>. The Rescue Mission is unable to accommodate special diets and no delivery time is available. Everything depends on how many meals are requested and routes are not made out until after the deadlines for requests then finalized the day of delivery.

I also have HEAP training on November 1<sup>st</sup>, so anyone needing help with their application forms is free to call and schedule an appointment. You will need to bring an ID, proof of rent or mortgage payment, your Social Security Benefits statement, proof of other income sources if any and a recent heating bill. Please remember, I am off Wednesdays. As always, I am here to help in any way I can so if you are struggling with an issue, please don't hesitate to call and I will do my best to help you.

I wish you all a Happy Thanksgiving and safe travels when the snow flies!

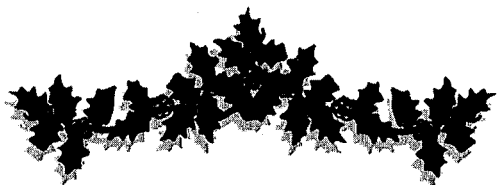

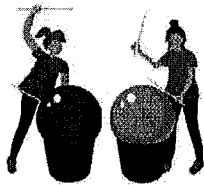

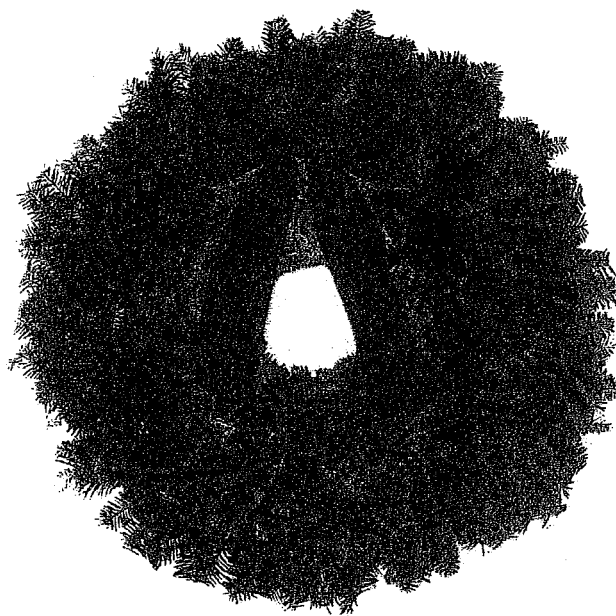
