The department of Adult and Long Term Care Services Mental Health number is 315-435-3355. Also, if you know someone who is having trouble, be kind and offer to spend some time with them.

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP) season is in full swing. Those of you who get SNAP will not need to apply. Those of you who received applications in the mail or need one can contact me and I can assist you if you need help. We expect the season to run until March but the sooner you get your application in the better. MaryBeth Basha, National Grid's Senior Consumer Advocate will join us here on December 7th at 11 am to share information on how to best benefit from several energy programs available. We will be making the clothespin wreath... Last year it was Autumn..this year WINTER or HOLIDAY...DO ONE OR BOTH

You will need to bring...
WIRED Ribbon of your choice..... one
spool should do it if it is a least 9ft. (Dollar
Tree)

Wire wreath frame...any size but remember you will buy the clothespins too...(Dollar Tree)

Any silk flowers, snowflakes, lights, embellishments you should bring. (Have I mentioned Dollar Tree?)

IF YOU HAVE WIRE CUTTERS PLEASE BRING THEM..

Clip type clothespins...depending on size you will need a least 2 packages
A 12 inch wreath takes roughly 72...(of course not all pins are created equal, so keep that in mind.) Buy the same brand for all your packages
Now here is a change in the lesson from last year...

Because the clothespins need to be soaked for the paint to absorb...please, please

Throw them in a gallon sized freezer bag or two with water covering them....soak them for at least one hour before class..just drain the water out before you leave home... bring the bags with the pins in them.

INSTEAD OF ACRYLIC PAINT I SUGGEST YOU PURCHASE SPRAY PAINT. This will ensure this is a one day project. We did the project in one day before using the acrylic paints and can still use them just bring a hair dryer or heat gun with you so you won't get paint all over your hands...bring gloves. This will help the clothes pins dry faster and we can move along.
