Dear Business Owner:

Once again, Onondaga County is making grant money available for villages, towns, and hamlets to improve their Main Street business district. Part of the comprehensive grant program is to improve business facades – as well as other aspects of businesses.

The grant requires the business owners to contribute at least 25% of the cost of the improvements. The idea is that façade upgrades would retain current business levels and hopefully enhance the businesses involved.

With any submission, please include a narrative on how you think the grant would help your business and improve the village business district. You will need to detail the façade improvements you desire and offer a budget. Contractors and architects can help design your upgrade and their cost can be part of the project. All plans must conform to the Village of Baldwinsville Overlay District guidelines and Architectural standards.

Submissions are due to the Village of Baldwinsville, 16 W. Genesee St, by August 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021.
